Art Parody Painting

Medium: Watercolor

Artist Inspiration: Grant Wood's American Gothic, Edvard Munch's The Scream or Da Vinci's Mona Lisa



Student Outcomes:

- I will develop skills and techniques in watercolor painting including value and color mixing.
- I will be able to identify characteristics of famous paintings such as "American Gothic" and "The Scream"
- I will be able to self-assess and critique my own work as well as the work of others by demonstrating knowledge of description, analysis, interpretation, and judgment.

Project Procedures:

- 1. Select a painting (*The Scream*, *American Gothic, The Mona Lisa*) and create a parody of the painting (2 thumbnail sketches).
- 2. Create rough draft with color (colored pencils or markers)
- 3. Create FINAL painting with watercolor. Incorporate color mixing techniques and value into painting to achieve value.
