CHINESE SCROLL PAINTING



Project Objectives:

- Students will explore the art and culture of **China**.
- Students will create a **watercolor** hand or hanging scroll using graded wash, flat wash, wet on wet, and dry brush techniques.
- Students will identify characteristics of landscapes and how the art elements and principles organize the composition.

Procedures:

- 1. Complete hand scroll and hanging scroll rough drafts (6).
- 2. Select **one** of the 6 drafts to use for FINAL project and add color (characteristic of Chinese landscape painting)
- 3. Practice watercolor techniques: flat wash, graded wash, wet on wet, and dry brush.
- 4. Complete final hand or hanging scroll incorporating all watercolor techniques.

Grading Criteria:

- Must include all watercolor techniques.
- Must include small landscape details.
- Must resemble Chinese scrolls studied in class (refer to list of characteristics in guided notes).
