Playing Card Portraits







Student Outcomes:

- I can observe and replicate motifs from a playing card to use in a self-portrait.
- I can compose two contrasting portraits in one composition.
- I can embellish my work with a patterned motif.

Procedure:

- 1. Using the playing face card as inspiration, create a rough draft that features yourself in the card. Include symbols, patterns, and a figure that represent you.
- 2. Enlarge your detailed sketch onto large paper using the document camera.
- 3. Trace over your contour lines with sharpie.
- 4. Plan your color using black, white, yellow, blue, and red.
- 5. Paint in sections of your self portrait.

Grading Criteria/ Checklist:

	I drew 2 representations of myself using symbols that represent me.
	I included patterns and compositional elements of a playing face card.
	I outlined by pencil drawing with Sharpie.
	I painted sections of my work with primary colors, white, and black.
