GARGOYLES 3-D Sculpture 7th Grade Visual Art



Project Objectives:

- T.S.W. explore the art and architecture of the middle east, focusing on the history of Gargoyle sculptures and their meaning/purpose.
- T.S.W. sculpt a 3-dimensional paper mache Gargoyle including both animal and human features.

Procedures:

- 1. Students will create **4** thumbnail sketches of gargoyles (including animal and human features).
- 2. Students will select **one** thumbnail to produce a **full-color/full-value** drawing of their creature.
- 3. Students will select materials and **plan** for production.
- 4. Students will begin constructing their gargoyle using the materials provided/brought in from home.
- 5. Students will begin using **paper mache** to **sculpt** the **detailed** features of the face.
- 6. When **fully dry**, spray paint to resemble stone.

Grading Criteria:

- Gargoyle must include both animal and human features.
- Gargoyle must be at least 5x5 inches in diameter (sizes and structures will vary).
