

Modern Mosaic Culture Combination Project



Project Objectives:

T.S.W. – Demonstrate knowledge of various characteristics from artwork of Japan, China, and Rome (specifically Koi fish, Chinese scrolls, and Roman mosaics).

T.S.W. – Demonstrate knowledge of crayon techniques to create value and color contrast.

T.S.W. – Demonstrate knowledge of description, analysis, and judgment by self-assessing own work and critiquing the work of others.

Procedures:

1. Create 4 thumbnail sketches of an interesting composition of Japanese Koi fish.
2. Create a rough draft of chosen thumbnail sketch.
3. Begin to create modern mosaic technique following teacher demonstration.
4. Begin to add color using markers and crayons following teacher demonstration.

Grading Criteria:

- Artwork must showcase characteristics of Japanese, Chinese, and Roman artwork discussed.
