POP ART Sculptures

Turning popular culture and everyday objects into ART.



Objectives:

- Students will explore the style of Art called POP ART.
- Students will be able to identify pop art by artists such as Andy Warhol, Peter Marx, Keith Haring, Wayne Thiebaud and more.
- Students will be inspired by today's popular culture to create paper mache sculptures of common objects.

Procedures (as a group):

- 1. Select an everyday object in today's popular culture.
- 2. Organize a plan of action. Gather necessary items for construction. (This may require looking through items at home or looking for material donations).
- 3. Begin construction (base, filler, etc.)
- 4. Add smooth layers of paper mache to mold the form of your sculpture.
- 5. Paint, add details.

Grading Criteria:

- Sculpture must be an ordinary everyday object or food item.
- Sculpture must stand alone.
- Painting must be accurate and neat (and it must represent the original object you were inspired to recreate).
