PORTFOLIO –Name with Creative Images



Project Objective(s):

- 1. Students will create a portfolio (to store their artwork) using creative letters, images, and patterns related to an overall theme.
- 2. Students will effectively use coloring techniques (shading, stippling, hatching, cross-hatching, outline, burnishing, and/or squiggle) to create the illusion of **FORM**.
- 3. Students will review and explore the art element **SHAPE** (organic and geometric).

Procedures:

- 1. Fold paper in half like a hamburger.
- 2. Using ONLY pencil, create your first name and last initial using creative subject matter (refer to example).
- 3. Outline your letters colored markers to create emphasis, color them in with colored pencil (using the coloring techniques) using value where necessary.
- 4. Draw a creative "frame" around your name
- 5. Create interesting silhouettes in the background of your portfolio.(If time permits)

Grading:

Project must include:

- 1. Your name (each letter should be a different creative image) with an overall theme.
- 2. Use the coloring techniques learned in class to create the illusion of 3-dimensionality.
