PORTRAITS

- Artists create portraits to express beauty, status, power, wealth, or character of their subjects.
- A wide range of media and techniques are used: drawing, painting, sculpture, photography, etc.
- Some artists create realistic images while others simplify the shapes and colors for a more abstract, dramatic effect.
- Artists sometimes include backgrounds, locations, objects, or other people in their portraits to show importance.
- Take a look at the next few slides to see these characteristics.
