Objectives:

- **T.S.W.** Explore artwork and techniques by Georgia O'Keeffe to create an abstract skeletal drawing.
- **T.S.W.** Demonstrate knowledge of graphite and charcoal drawing techniques including contour outlines, shading, and blending.
- **T.S.W.** Self assess and critique their own work as well as the work of others demonstrating aesthetic knowledge of description, analysis, interpretation, and judgment.

Procedures:

- 1. Students will take several photos of skeletal structure. Take photos of flowers that are around the artroom. Devices will act as viewfinders to create an interesting composition.
- 2. Create 2-4 thumbnail sketches in sketchbooks experimenting with contour outline drawing.
- 3. Create a full page rough draft drawing experimenting with contour outline and value drawing techniques.
- 4. Create a FINAL drawing using graphite and charcoal.
- 5. Add color using oil pastels, watercolor paint, and/or sharple to the background.

Grading Criteria:

- Artist must capture an interesting, balanced composition (photo/viewfinder).
- Artwork must appear 3-dimensional as a result of value techniques.
- Drawing of skeletal structure must be reasonably accurate.
